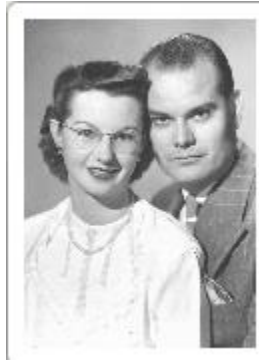


# JAMES MATHEY HUEBSCH

## James Mathey Huebsch

March 27, 1918 ~ March 5, 2016

James Mathey Huebsch passed away March 5, 2016 after 97 years, 10 months of life. He was preceded in death by his wife of almost 70 years, Dorothy Marie (Moore); his parents, Lafayette and Mary (Mathey); his siblings, Bob (Mary), Bettie Nielson (Cliff), Ronnie, and Marilyn Bond (Virgil). He is survived by his sister-in-law, Marlys Huebsch (Ronnie), nieces, nephews and their children, along with many friends.

Jim was born in Webster County, IA living most of his young life in Ft. Dodge, IA. He graduated from Ft. Dodge High School, attended Iowa Central Community College for two years and then graduated from U of IA earning his BA. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1940. While at Scott Field, he met Dorothy; they were united in marriage three years later on April 12, 1945.

After basic training, Jim attended radio and communication schooling in FL. He was assigned to the 98th Bombardment Group and shipped to the North African front during WWII. Jim stayed in the Air Force continuing his career in communications and electronics until his honorable discharge in 1961 as Lt. Col. He continued this work, now as a Civil Service employee, for 20 years at Lowry Air Base.
